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A NOTE FROM THE EDUCATORS

We have been having lots of fun with the children as they are mastering new skills.

April's weather can still be chilly outside so please send your child in oversized splash pants so they will be warm and dry when playing outdoors. If you wish for your child to wear one of our MEC rain suites please reach out to the teachers and we can be sure to dress them in a suit over their outdoor wear to keep mud and sand under control. The children often engage in sand play and in the mud kitchen which can result in muddy play!

If you feel it is time for a meeting with the teachers, please reach out to Supervisor Tracey or Assistant Supervisor Patty and they will set a time to meet with you via Zoom. We are happy to assist each child in meeting their individual goals. We also wanted to remind you that regular developmental screening is very important as the children are growing and changing so quickly. <u>Here</u> is a useful link to Ages & Stages. We sometimes send home ASQs to help assess strengths and areas needing focus. If you wish for the next age ASQ for your child please reach out.

Children will continue to be introduced to fine motor development as teachers offer opportunities to use pencils, various mediums and scissors. We noticed on our Special Me posters that many families have pets at home, which might prompt talk about our pets at home. Our KP class have been having fun with telling jokes and show & share!


