



Child Guidance for Contravention of Children

Child Guidance and Policies/Procedures for Contravention of Children / Breach of prohibitive practices

- When required, a child will be redirected to an alternate activity giving him/her the choice between two areas (e.g. sand table or workbench).
- When required, a child will be assisted in sorting out feelings and aggression. A child will never be left alone. A child will not be denied a snack.
- Under no circumstances an educator, support staff or volunteer teacher, strike a child, belittle a child or express themselves in an uncontrolled manner. This applies to parents in their parent/child relationship when at the school.
- Volunteers, in the role of an assistant, should they disregard child guidance policies, shall be given a verbal warning and a copy of our "Child Guidance and Implementation Record Guidelines". Should a second breach of these guidelines occur, the volunteer would be asked to discontinue volunteering at the school..
- A supervisor or educator, who should disregard behavioral guidance policies, shall be suspended for one week without pay. Should a second breach of these policies occur, employment shall be terminated immediately.
- In any instance, the supervisor and President will be notified immediately and reports made to the appropriate agencies.
